There will be times, due to inclement weather, natural disaster, or other happenings, that MCT will not be able to hold in-clinic visits. We have developed this policy to address these times.

In any case where inclement weather, natural disasters, or other happenings impact our ability to hold in-clinic appointments, clients will be contacted by the scheduling team or their therapist to notify them that their in-clinic appointment will be:

1. Rescheduled to a Telehealth visit.

2. Cancelled, if your therapist is not able to provide a Telehealth visit. We will make every effort to reschedule your appointment.

Do not assume an appointment has been canceled even if area schools have closed, or opened late. We begin contacting clients in the order of their appointment so appointments later in the day may not hear from us in the early AM.

If you are unable to get to your clinic due to weather, disaster, or other emergencies and your clinic is still open please contact your scheduler by calling the office or emailing our scheduling team at mctschedule@nt4kids.org as soon as possible to reschedule or cancel your appointment.

We make every effort to communicate any closure updates that affect our ability to provide in-clinic appointments.
